PATIENT INFORMATION – FOREIGN TRAVEL ADVICE/VACCINATIONS

Our Practice Nurse, Liz Parker, is trained and very experienced in advising our patients when planning to travel abroad. Liz will be able to advise you on any health issues, vaccinations required for your destination and general travel advice.

FEES

The following vaccinations can be given at the Surgery:

Hepatitis B (course of 3 injections)	<u>£60.00</u>	(single booster £20.00)
Meningitis ACWY	<u>£20.00</u>	
Rabies (course of 3 injections)	<u>£130.00</u>	
Japanese Encephalitis (course of 3 injections)	<u>£130.00</u>	

PRIVATE PRESCRIPTIONS

The following items can be provided on a private prescription for you to obtain from the Pharmacist, which we will then administer.

Each private prescription will cost **£15.00** (please note there will be a charge for the vaccine itself which you will pay to the Pharmacist).

Malaria

ALL fees are payable BEFORE the vaccination/prescription is given.

Payments can be made by cheque (with a bankers card) or by cash – **please note we do not accept credit/debit cards.**

TIMETABLE FOR VACCINATIONS

Vaccination	Ideally should be given
Hepatitis B	3 months before departure (minimum 6 weeks)
Meningitis	4 weeks before departure
Rabies	6 weeks before departure
Japanese Encephalitis	6 weeks before departure
Tick-borne Encephalitis	6 weeks before departure
Malaria	1 – 4 weeks before departure
Yellow Fever	2 weeks before departure
